

DAA Automatic Brass Marker Instruction sheet

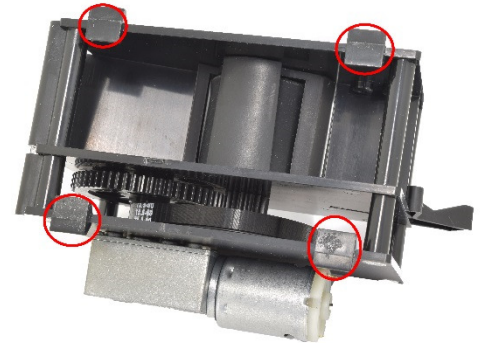
Box Contains:

- Assembled main unit
- Power supply (110v, and 220v compatible) with cable and on/off switch
- Output funnel with 40 cm feed spring
- Bag of parts containing feeder assembly, marker holder and adaptors, 2 Sharpie's, rubber O-rings, rubberized pads
- Instruction sheet

Setting Up Your DAA Automatic Brass Marker:

Step 1: Stick rubber pads on base

In the bag of parts, you will find 4 rubber pads with adhesive tape. Stick these to the machine's base to help stabilize it before use.



Step 2: Attach the Feeder Assembly

The feeder assembly attaches to the main unit using the two M4 screws which are in place on the sidewall. Remove the two screws, fit the feeder assembly onto the side wall and reinsert the screws.



Step 3: Insert the Marker Holder

Slide the Marker Holder into the Marker Holder base plate which is on the top of the machine. You can slide it further in or out to change the location of the stripes made on your ammo. If you are using the Sharpie markers, also use the included Sharpie Adaptor pipes to get a correct fit. If you plan to use larger markers, you can remove those adaptor pipes. Markers up to 15mm in diameter can be used.
